FAITHFULNESS – Stewardship of the True Riches

What is Faithfulness?

- Old meaning: Full of faith (still true spiritually!)
- Today's meaning:
 - Loyal
 - Trustworthy
 - Keeps promises
 - Fulfills duties
- Mentioned **116 times** in the Bible (OT & NT combined).
- A faithful person handles what is entrusted to them with care.

Jesus - Our Model of Faithfulness

- Called the Faithful High Priest (Heb. 2:17)
- Now we are **priests** of a new kingdom (1 Pet. 2:5, 9)
- He served, healed, forgave and calls us to do the same (Acts 10:38; Matt. 10:7–8)
- God has anointed us too (2 Cor. 1:21)
- We carry His treasure in **earthen vessels** (2 Cor. 4:5–7)

Stewardship Basics

- A **steward** manages another's property God has entrusted us with His Kingdom.
- Be faithful with:
 - o Your life
 - Your gifts
 - o Your ministry
 - o People around you

E Bible Examples of Faithful Stewards

- Joseph in Potiphar's house (Gen. 39:4-5)
- Solomon asked for wisdom, not riches (2 Chron. 1)
- Moses was called faithful and a friend of God (Heb. 3:5; Ex. 33:11)
- Paul: from persecutor to chosen vessel (1 Tim. 1:12; 2 Cor. 3:5–6)

Real Faithfulness in Action

- Be faithful in **little things** (Luke 16:10)
- Use your gifts or lose them (2 Tim. 1:6)
- **Give** what God has given you: forgiveness, healing, joy (Matt. 10:7–8)

Stewardship Scriptures

- 1 Pet. 4:10 Use your gifts to serve others.
- Matt. 25:28 Don't bury your talent.
- 1 Cor. 4:1–2 Stewards must be found faithful.

Warnings & Encouragement

- **Don't hoard** God's anointing use it to bless others.
- Be careful not to misuse God's power for personal gain.
- The Kingdom of God is about giving, not getting.
